12 COUNT I

13 The said defendant, **PYOTR A BONDARUK**, is accused by the District Attorney of and for
14 the County of Sonoma, State of California, by this Information, of a **felony**, in that on or about the
15 **10th day of May, 1998**, in the County of Sonoma, State of California, the said defendant, **PYOTR**
16 **A BONDARUK**, did violate Section **289(d)** of the Penal Code, in that he did unlawfully cause the
17 penetration of the genital and anal openings of another for the purpose of sexual arousal,
18 gratification, and abuse by a foreign object, substance, instrument, and device, and by an unknown
19 object, the victim being unconscious of the nature of the act, this being known by the defendant.

20 NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require you to register pursuant to Penal Code
21 Section 290. Willful failure to register is a crime.

22 COUNT II

23 As and for a further and separate cause of action, being a different offense from but
24 connected in its commission with crimes set forth hereinabove, the said defendant, **PYOTR A**
25 **BONDARUK**, is accused by the District Attorney of and for the County of Sonoma, State of
26 California, by this Information, of a **felony**, in that on or about the **10th day of May, 1998**, in the

1 County of Sonoma, State of California, the said defendant did violate Section 289(a) of the Penal
2 Code, in that the said defendant did unlawfully cause the penetration of the genital and anal openings
3 of another for the purpose of sexual arousal, gratification, and abuse by a foreign object, substance,
4 instrument, and device, and by an unknown object, accomplished by force, violence, duress, menace
5 and fear of immediate and unlawful bodily injury on the victim or another.

6 NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section
7 1192.7(c).

8 NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require you to register pursuant to Penal Code
9 Section 290. Willful failure to register is a crime.

11 Contrary to the form, force and effect of the Statute in such case made and provided and
12 against the peace and dignity of the People of the State of California.
