For a further and separate cause of action, being a different offense from but connected in its commission as the causes set forth above: On or about January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2015, in the County of Sacramento SVITLANA KYBYCH, SERHIY KYBYCH, and OLEH KYBYCH, being a person required to make, render, sign or verify a sales tax return for sellers permit number SR Y JHF 102-178245 issued to Victoria's Massage & Health Products, Inc., unlawfully filed false or fraudulent sales tax returns for the third quarter of 2015, with the intent to defeat or evade the reporting, assessment or payment of a tax liability, in violation of Revenue and Taxation Code section 7152(a), a misdemeanor to wit: Defendants underreported sales tax owed and failed to remit sales tax to the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration, an amount of \$4,067.85.

COUNT TWENTY NINE Sales Tax Evasion

For a further and separate cause of action, being a different offense from but connected in its commission as the causes set forth above: On or about January 1, 2013 through December 31, 2015, in the County of Sacramento SVITLANA KYBYCH, SERHIY KYBYCH, and OLEH KYBYCH, being a person required to make, render, sign or verify a sales tax return for sellers permit number SR Y JHF 102-178245 issued to Victoria's Massage & Health Products, Inc., unlawfully filed false or fraudulent sales tax returns for the fourth quarter of 2015, with the intent to defeat or evade the reporting, assessment or payment of a tax liability, in violation of Revenue and Taxation Code section 7152(a), a misdemeanor to wit: Defendants underreported sales tax owed and failed to remit sales tax to the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration, an amount of \$4,885.13.

Pursuant to Penal Code Section 1054.5(b), the People hereby informally request that defense counsel provide the People with discovery as required by Penal Code section 1054.3.
