13 Judicial District, State of Alaska, DANIEL P SERKOV intentionally caused the death of
14 Dmitriy Sergiyenko.

16 All of which is a unclassified felony offense being contrary to and in violation of
17 AS11.41.100(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

19 COUNT III

21 That on or about January 20, 2023, at or near Delta Junction, in the Fourth
22 Judicial District, State of Alaska, DANIEL P SERKOV destroyed, mutilated, altered,
23 suppressed, concealed, or removed physical evidence with intent to impair its verity or
24 availability in an official proceeding or a criminal investigation.

26 All of which is a class C felony offense being contrary to and in violation of
27 11.56.610(a)(1) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

COUNT IV

That on or about January 20, 2023, at or near Delta Junction, in the Fourth Judicial District, State of Alaska, DANIEL P SERKOV having no right to do so or any reasonable ground to believe the defendant had such a right, with reckless disregard for the risk of harm to or loss of the property or with intent to cause substantial inconvenience to another, tampered with property of another.

All of which is a class B misdemeanor offense being contrary to and in violation of AS11.46.486(a)(1) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

I, Investigator Al Bell

attest to the following and state:

The Alaska State Troopers in Fairbanks are investigating a Murder Investigation involving 33-year-old Daniel Serkov of North Pole, after AST received a report of a double homicide at 2775 Tanana Loop Extension in Delta Junction. Investigators learned two adult males, later identified as 44-year-old Andrey Dorozhin and 35-year-old Dmitriy Sergiyenko of Delta were found shot to death at the aforementioned residence.

Moments upon receiving the initial report, Serkov responded to the Fairbank Police Department to report an unrelated incident. During his contact with FPD, Serkov received a phone call, notifying him it was known he shot and killed the two men. Serkov ultimately admitted to law-enforcement he shot and killed Dorozhin and Sergiyenko.

Serkov told investigators, the day prior, he recently moved into a Russian rehabilitation center in Delta Junction due to his chronic drug addiction. Serkov said after being confronted by the two men, to turn over his prescription pills and cigarettes he became extremely angry. Serkov told Investigators in America, you can protect yourself if someone is trying to take your pills. Serkov told Investigators the two men approached him in an aggressive manner, by cornering him.

Serkov said he froze and became extremely angry as they approached him, he thought they were going to grab a knife that was sitting on the table and stab him with it and take his pills. Serkov did mention the two men threatened to stab him in Russian language as they pointed at the knife; although the knife was never picked up.

Serkov told Investigators he grabbed his SIG 365, 9mm handgun from his back pocket and center punched, shooting both men in the chest. Serkov said the first male fell and the other man attempted to run; however, he started spraying bullets towards both of them.

Serkov told Investigators he emptied one magazine, reloaded another and continued shooting at the men. Serkov told Investigators he emptied both magazines, and prior to departing he walked outside and shot Dorozhin and Sergiyenko dog that was outside in front of the residence. Serkov told Investigators the dog was vicious, and he previously told the men if the dog caused him problems, he would kill it.

Serkov said he grabbed the knife from the table and went to stab the men; however, at that point he came to terms and realized what he had done and refrain from stabbing the men. Serkov told Investigators he wanted to use the same knife on the men that they wanted to stab him with.

Serkov said he picked up spent rounds and put them in his jacket pocket. He told Investigators, he then drove to the Cushman Gun Range and shot some rounds off, before going to Costco and selling his jacket to a couple for \$45.00. Serkov said he left the spent rounds in the jacket pocket and the male half gave him his jacket for free.

Serkov told Investigators he then drove to Alaska Ammo, where he complained to the store employees about the performance of the gun and requested, they clean it, as he implied, they did. Serkov told Investigators he then drove to FPD for an unrelated issue regarding his prior conviction and the conditions of possessing a firearm with that conviction.

Serkov told Investigators his intent for going to FPD was the hope that they would confiscate his firearm due to a violation and law-enforcement would already have the murder weapon; however, unbeknownst to them they would still be looking for it.

Investigators executed a search warrant on the aforementioned residence and located the deceased bodies of 44-year-old Andrey Dorozhin and 35-year-old Dmitriy Sergiyenko. The scene and the statements of Serkov corroborated the murders of the two men as well as the dog. The SIG 365, firearm was recovered in the possession of Serkov.

Serkov violated AS.11.41.100 by intentionally causing death to both Sergiyenko and Dorozhin.

Serkov violated AS.11.56.610 by tampering with physical evidence by removing physical evidence with the intent to impair its verity or availability in an official proceeding or criminal investigation.
